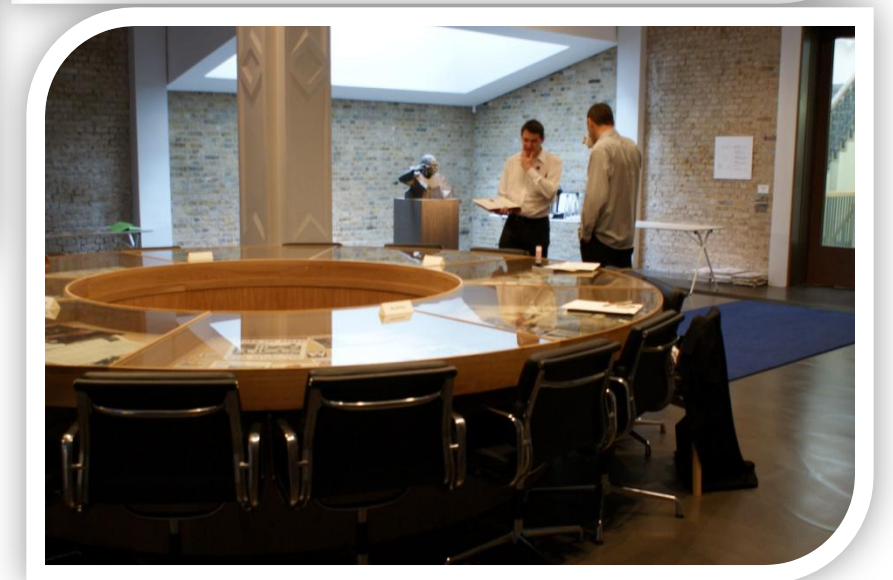
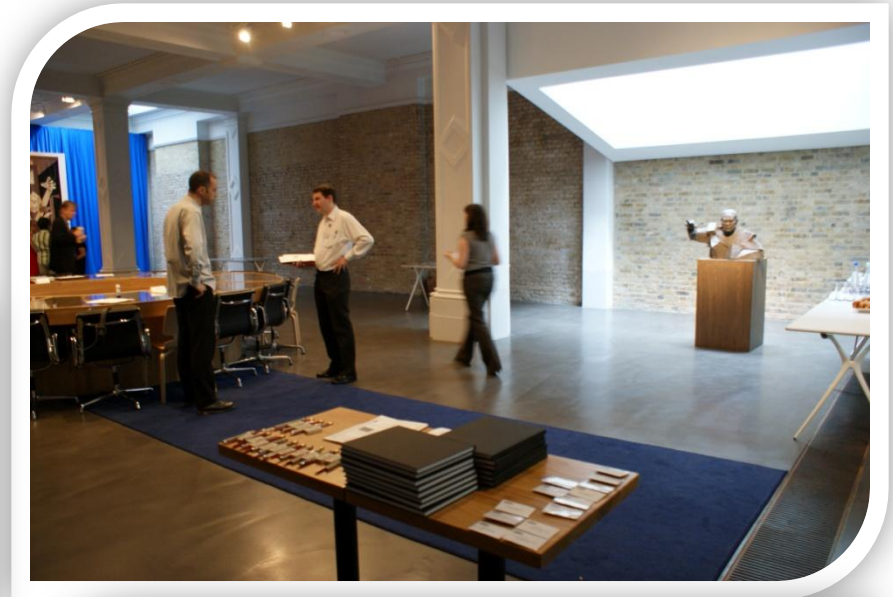

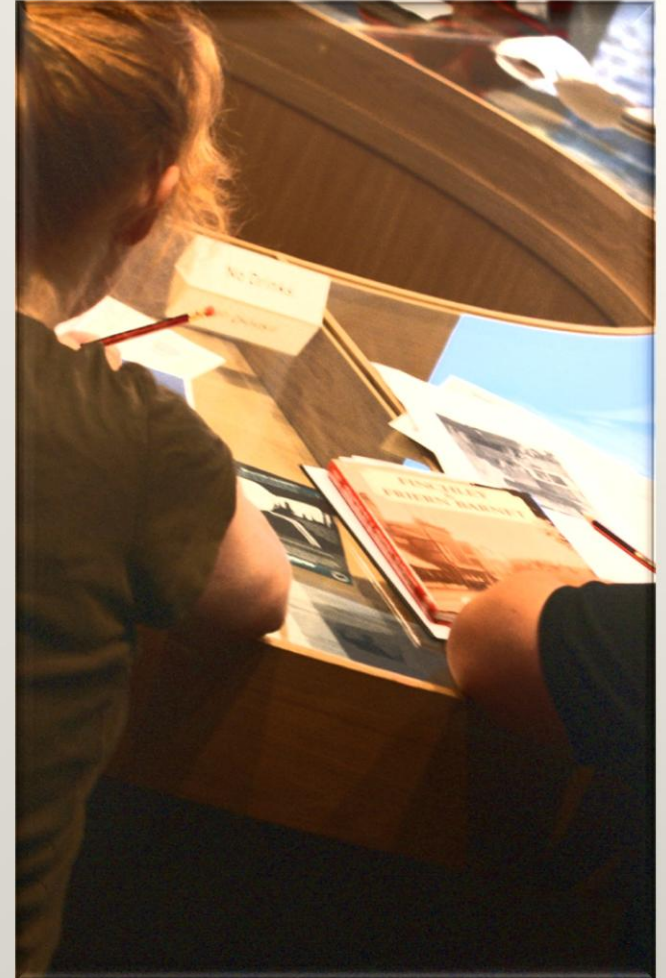

**WAR OF TWO WORLDS**

**OPTIMISTIC**

- need to be self-sufficient leads to greater co-operation locally and across borders
- technology makes this possible - ironic!
- "what can I tell you" not "what can I sell you?"
- we are healthier, systems are more sustainable as they are local.
- barter and alternative local economies.

**PESSIMISTIC**

- Loss of trust + protectionism leads to rise in nationalism, and possibly conflict.
- Financial gridlock + lack of natural resources enhance this.
- Government control, required by conflict + protectionism, enabled by technology.
- Rise of the black market, alternative barter.
- People don't trust the ruling power - tech enables them to group together.

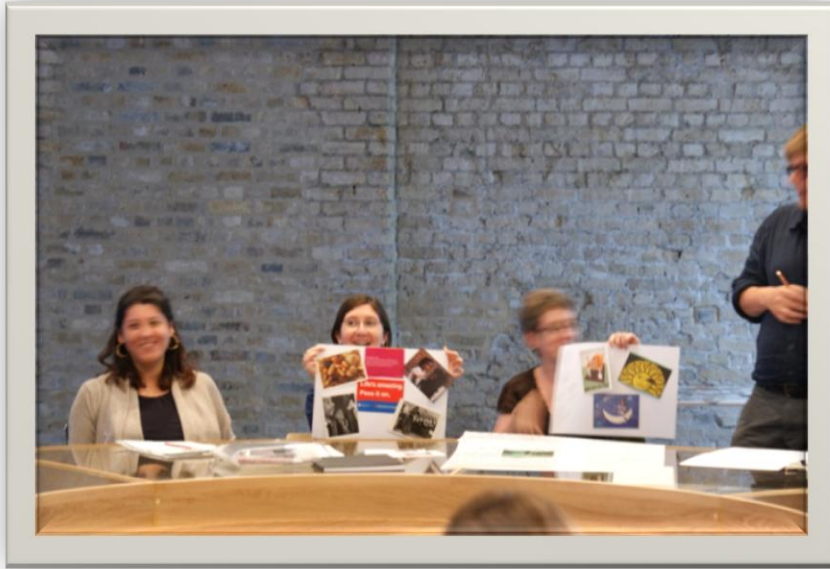

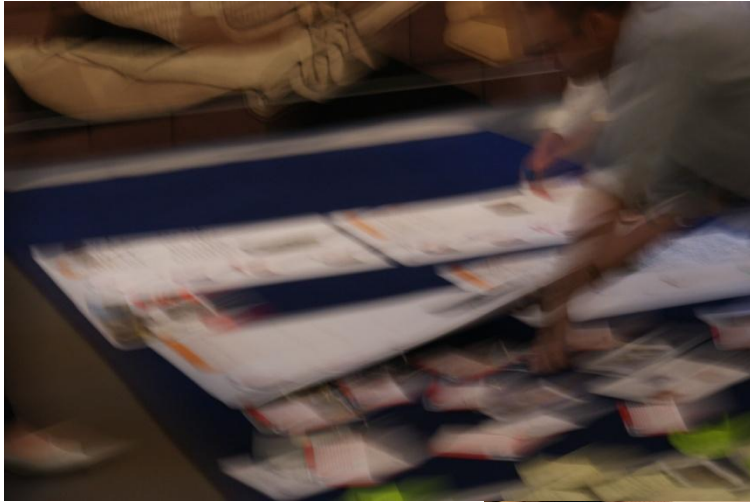
